Campers will be at the dojo on Monday, Wednesday and Fridays and at a Park on Tuesdays and Thursdays - rain or shine. Lunch is provided on Thursdays and usually consists of hotdog and hamburgers. Pizza is ordered on Fridays for a \$5.00 charge. Your child is not required to participate in Friday Pizza and may bring lunch from home.

IMPORTANT PARENT INFORMATION:

1. Please arrive on time on the days we have field trips. If your child is not at our facility by 8:45 on the days we go to a park, you will be responsible for transporting your child to our location. PLEASE LABEL YOUR CHILD'S BELONGINGS.
2. Method of payments accepted Cash, Check, Debit Card, Visa or MasterCard.
3. Please pick up your child on time. Late charges will apply for children picked up after 6:30.
4. If your child has a fever or any other contagious infection/condition, they must wait 24hrs before returning to Camp.
5. Atlanta Budokan will not be held responsible for the loss of any valuables your child brings into the dojo or lake facility.
6. Any child involved in stealing or any other altercation with other students and/or staff will be given one warning for their first offense and a phone call will be made to their parent or legal guardian. A second offense will result in a one-week suspension without refund of tuition. Third offense is grounds for dismissal from Camp without refund.

LIST OF REQUIRED ITEMS FOR CAMP:

1. Bag lunch, snacks and beverage (**NO SODA**)
2. Swimsuit, towel and change of clothing on park days
3. Sun block
4. Plastic drink cup/water bottle clearly marked with your child's name
5. Asthma medicine and Epi-pens.

RULES FOR CAMP:

1. I will begin each day with a positive attitude.
2. I will greet everyone with a friendly smile and a friendly greeting every day.
3. I will strive to always be honest in everything I do.
4. I will take pride in being respectful to everyone and using good manners.
5. I will take responsibility for my actions and will not make excuses.
6. I will show respect for my own and others' property.
7. I will clean up after myself.
8. I will always be on time and be prepared to do whatever I have to do.
9. Behave and buckle up in the van/car. No Horseplay!
10. Put your things in the changing room.
11. Unless you are in class, do not TOUCH, PUNCH, HIT, KICK, (or any other form of contact) with another student or instructor.
12. Follow all instructions and directions that are given by your instructors, adult volunteers and camp counselors.
13. No bad language or name-calling is allowed.

DISCIPLINE POLICY:

In order to maintain a safe and quality program, we occasionally find it necessary to discipline a student. We feel that effective and positive ways of behavior management are:

1. REDIRECTION: We will stop the child and calmly learn what has happened, why and how they see it, and then suggest other ways of handling the situation. Then, we will redirect their attention.
2. SEPARATION: We will have the child play apart from the rest of the group and rest for a short time. This gives them an opportunity to calm down. Then we will explain other ways of good behavior.

If a child's behavior remains problematic, a parent conference will be held. If there is little or no improvement in the child's behavior after the parent conference, termination of enrollment may become necessary. Termination of enrollment will be at the discretion of Atlanta Budokan's Administrative Staff.
